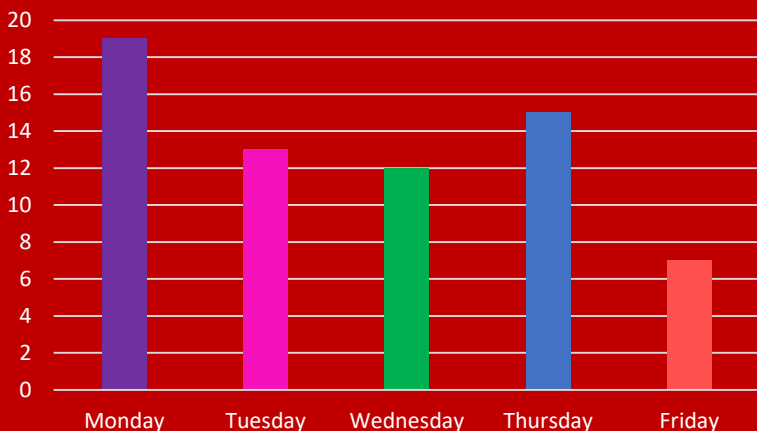

Autumn Term Overview:



The Autumn Term 2017 has seen the start of LMP Wraparound Care at Our Lady & St Joseph Primary School. This has provided parents with a convenient, affordable and Ofsted Registered extended childcare provision hosted on the school site each day from straight after school until 6:00pm.

The daily provision includes the opportunity for children to try a specialist activity in sports, performing arts or creative arts. Following on from the activity a healthy snack is provided at 4:30pm. For the remaining part of the session children have a choice of games and other activities which they can enjoy. The programme is delivered by Let Me Play's team of Play Workers and specialist activity instructors who have built up strong relationships with the children that attend the programme since the start of the year.

Over the course of the Autumn Term

46 Our Lady & St Joseph pupils attended the provision. Let Me Play has worked to support the varying needs for childcare of parents Band carers from the school. In total **116** last minute ad hoc bookings were taken to help accommodate Parents who have required childcare at very short notice. Throughout the Autumn Term, the staff have implemented Different themes each week, to ensure activities are varied and engaging. A couple of these included activities around Harvest, Halloween and Guy Fawkes Night. Pupils from every different year group throughout the school have attended the programme with a large proportion of pupils (**29**) being from KS1. In total **966** daily bookings were made onto the Autumn programme. Let Me Play has worked hard to keep communication with parents informative and frequent. From parent feedback, it is clear that most parents are extremely satisfied with the service and that the children enjoy attending the provision.
