Aims:

1. To raise attainment of pupils who are working below age expectancy.
2. To identify and challenge pupils, who with support may achieve greater depth.
3. Continue to track and monitor pupils' attainment and progress.
4. To establish early interventions in EYFS to aid good progress towards GLD.
5. Learning Mentor to provide support and guidance to help pupils who are experiencing difficulties in learning due to social, emotional or behavioural problems.
6. To provide an opportunity for pupils to attend an extended schools learning provision.
7. Ensure pupils have the opportunity to experience a creative enrichment program.
8. New reading scheme providing children with individualised, independent practice in the six essential areas of reading including; phonological awareness, phonics, structural awareness, automaticity, fluency, vocabulary and comprehension.
