Technical notes

The following considerations apply to the data presented in this Final data booklet v1.0:

The 2015 EYFSP, Phonics and KS1 data in this booklet contains the results submitted to the DfE by schools via The Hackney Learning Trust (HLT) at the end of the 2014-15 academic year.

The 2015 KS2 data is a combination of test results submitted by schools to the DfE via the NCA Tools and subsequently received by HLT from the DfE, and KS2 Teacher Assessments submitted to the DfE by schools via HLT. This KS2 dataset is now final and based on the performance tables checking feed published by the DfE on the 12th December 2014. The census data displayed has been sourced from the January 2015 school census, with the exception of the attendance data. (Attendance data is reported retrospectively in the school census and therefore this data, although relating to the Autumn and Spring terms, is from the combined January and May 2015 census collections.)

Where published the 2015, 2014, 2013, 2012 and 2011 figures contained within this booklet match the final, published figures released by the Department of Education through Statistical First Releases and the School & College Performance Tables.

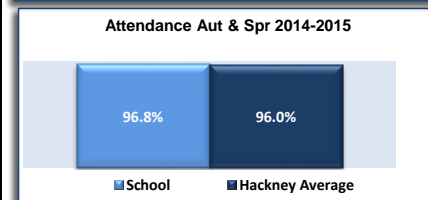
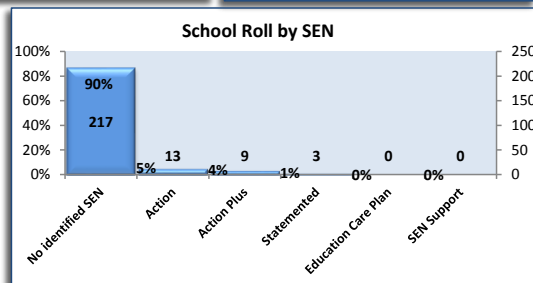
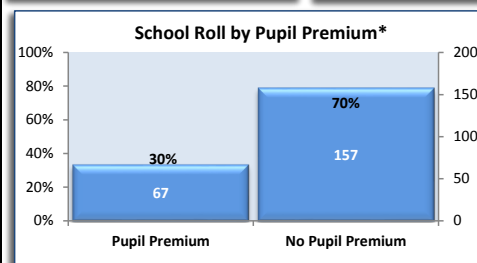
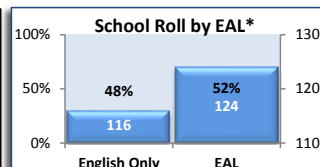
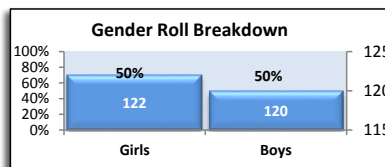
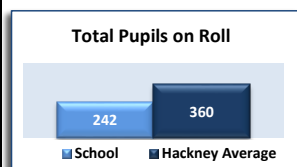

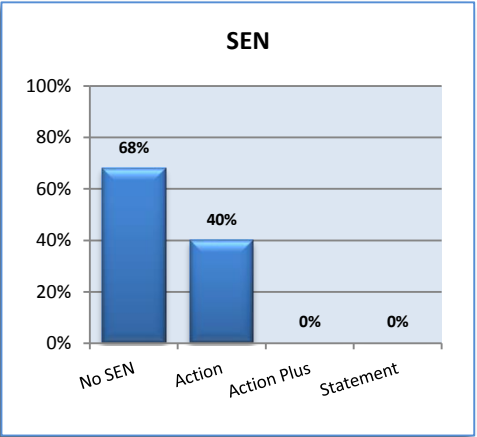
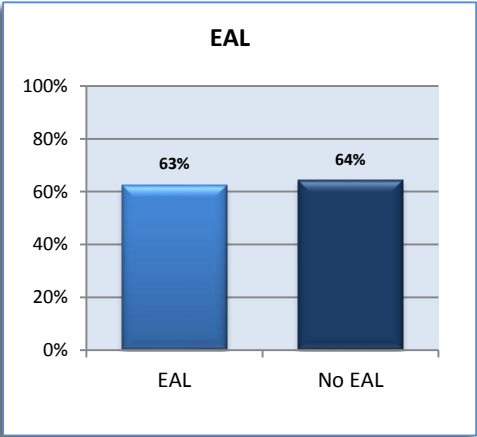
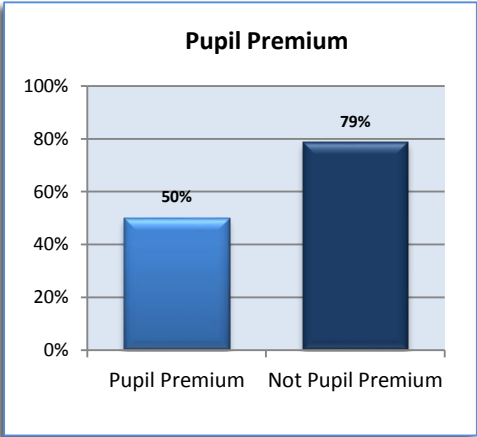
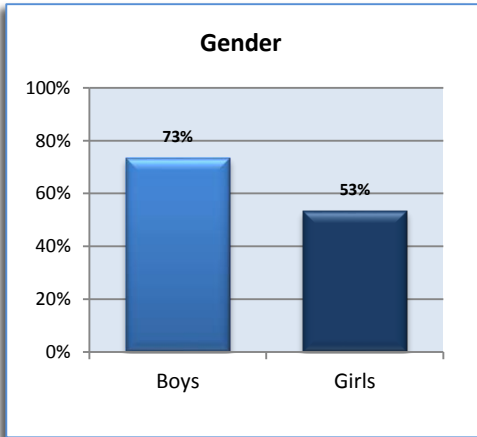
% Pupils Achieving Level 5 and above in Writing

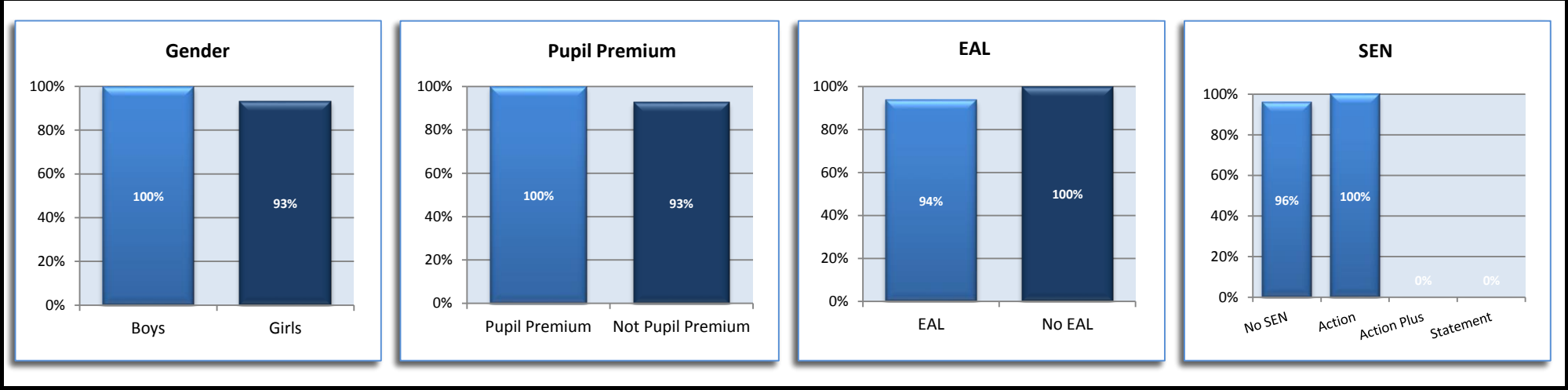

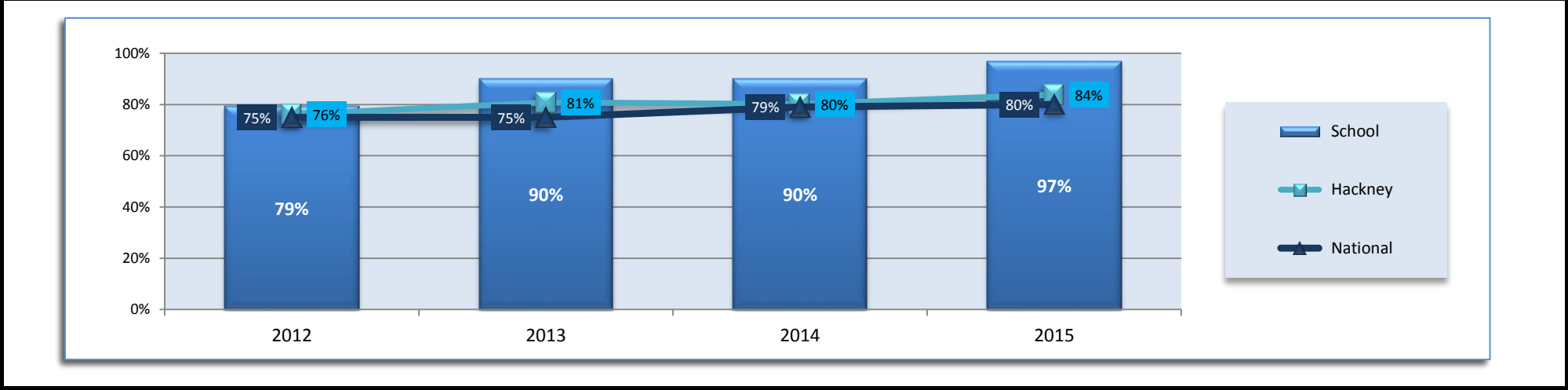
KS2 Level 4 + in Reading, Writing and Maths by Pupils' Characteristics, 2015

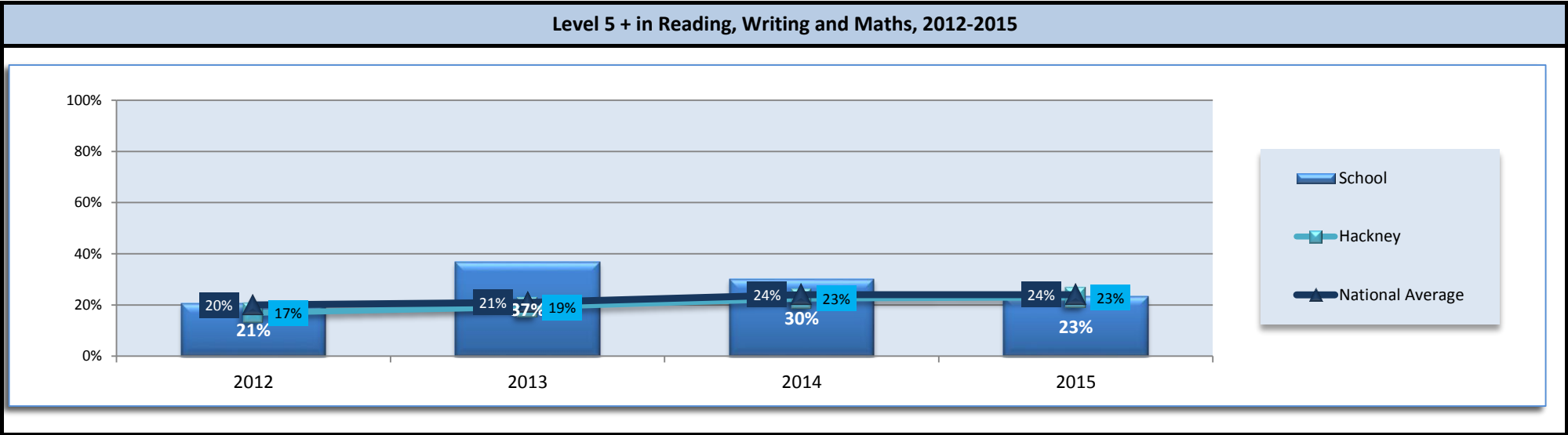
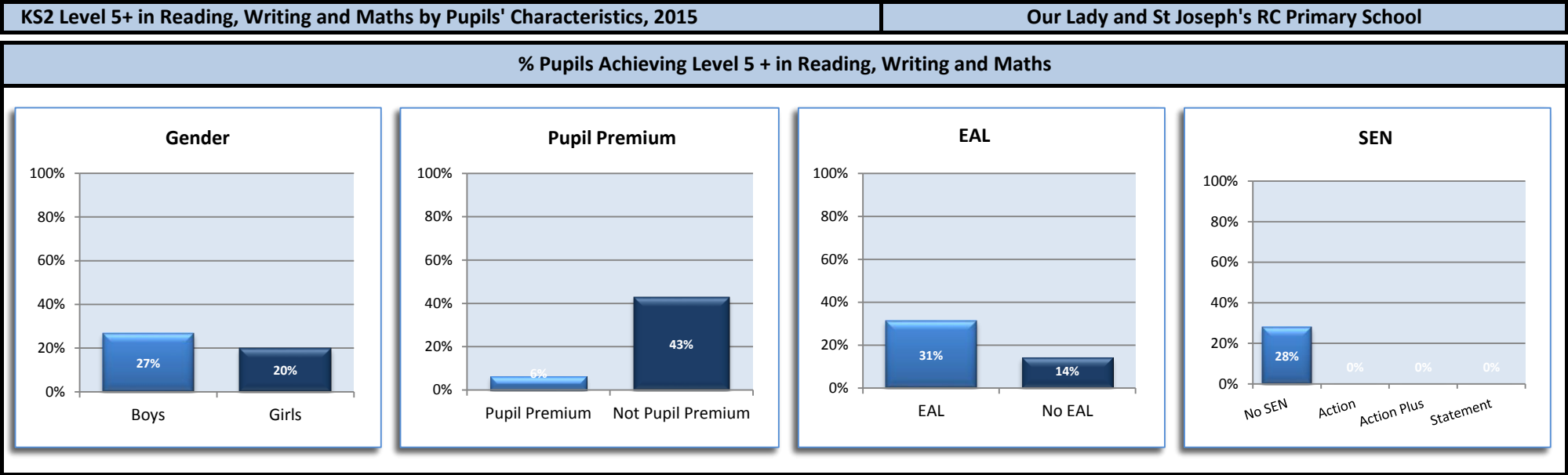

Level 4 + in Reading, Writing and Maths, 2012-2015



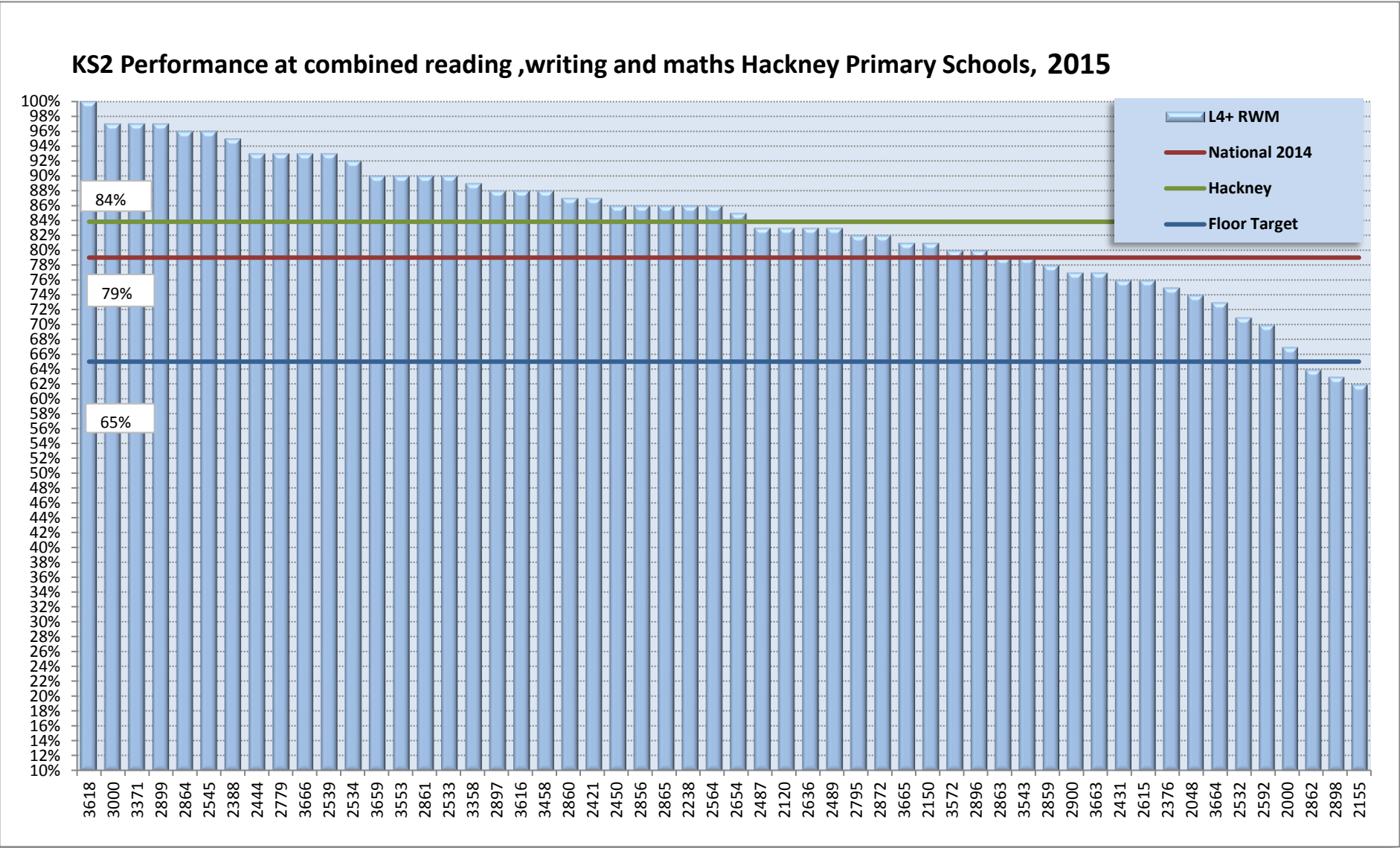

Guidance Notes**General:**

This section has been added to the booklet in order to clarify the methods used to calculate the data contained in this report.
This section is not intended to be fully a comprehensive guide to data analysis; it is an attempt to create transparency to the figures, and to help users to comprehend the methodology

Background data match (applicable for all key stages)

All key stage results have been matched to the background characteristics from the school census by the DfE through the following method and order:

The test data was matched to pupils' background information from the January census using, firstly, UPN and then, where the UPN was not successful, by name.

Pupils not found using the above process were then searched for in the May census, again by UPN and then name. Ethnicity is not collected in the May census, so any pupils not found at this stage were searched for from the National pupil database (NPD) but where not found were marked as unclassified ethnicity and therefore not included into the ethnicity breakdowns.

Pupils that could not be matched using either the January or May census collections were marked as unclassified for all of their characteristics and are not shown in the pupil group calculations.

Pupil premium has been matched from the DfE pupil premium data feed reflecting those that were eligible based on January school census.

In this version of the booklet the DfE table checking data was used for obtaining the Pupil premium / FSM and mobility data for KS2

Prior attainment match (KS2 Only)

In this final booklet 1.0 (based on the checking data released on 12th December 2015) the DfE has matched KS2 results data to KS1 prior attainment and added in all pupil background characteristics.

Provisional / final data booklet

The KS2 data is now final.

All pupils removed (who were approved by the DfE) in the checking exercise are removed from this final data booklet.

All national comparison figures are from the performance tables field "England - All Schools" with the exception of the progress which uses the state-funded information.

Definitions:**Term of Birth:**

Pupils born between the 1.9.YY-31.12.YY have been classified as autumn born, 1.01.YY+1-30.04.YY+1 as spring born, and 1.5.YY+1-31.08.YY+1 as summer born.

Children who were out of year group have been classified with the term closest to their dob. (Older out of year group as autumn and younger out of year group as Summer)

Mobility: (KS2 only)

Pupils have been marked as mobile if they arrived to the school after the 11.9.2013 (i.e. after the start of year 5)

- This is the cut of the DfE seems to be using in the checking data

Prior attainment band: (KS2 only)

Pupils are divided into low, middle and high prior attainment bands according to their KS1 result. These bands are calculated as follows:

The pupil's average points score of reading, writing and maths is calculated.

Pupils with a points score of less than 12 (i.e. below level 2) are classified as low attainers, those with an APS of between 12 and 17.99 (i.e. at level 2) as middle attainers, and those with 18 or above (i.e. above level 2) as high attainers. Pupils where it was not possible to match their KS1 results have not been included into these calculations.

Progress calculations

Where possible, a pupil's prior attainment at KS1 has been traced and matched into the KS2 data so the progress between KS1 and KS2 can be calculated. The following rules have then been used in working out the progress.

Any pupils who were not in an English maintained school at the end of KS1 will not have any KS1 teacher assessments.

In the KS2 tests, pupils can achieve level 3, 4, 5 or 6. Pupils who are believed to be working below level 3 should not be entered for the tests and will be given a test level B (below the level of the test). A small number of pupils who take the tests do not achieve sufficient marks to be awarded a level 3, these pupils will be awarded either a compensatory level 2 (if they score one or two marks below that required for a level 3) or N (not awarded a level).

It is also possible for pupils to be given the following levels

A (absent for one or more of the papers in that subject)

M (result missing)

T (working at the level of the tests but unable to access them)

X (one or more of the pupil's papers in that subject was lost before marking),

S (pending maladministration investigation)

Q (maladministration).

In the KS2 teacher assessments, pupils can be awarded W (working towards level 1), level 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6. A small number of pupils may also have A (pupil was absent for a large part of the year) or D (Disapplied from the national curriculum).

The progress calculation uses the KS2 test result if that is level 3, 4, 5 or 6 but uses the teacher assessment in all other cases.

In other cases the teacher assessment is used instead. When a teacher assessment is used for the B/N pupils it is only possible for the pupil to obtain the maximum of Level 2

- i.e. If a pupil got a Level N/B from the test level it is not possible to get a higher level than 2 based on the TA level

Once the KS1 and KS2 attainment has been calculated, the number of levels of progress made is calculated using the formula: KS2 level – KS1 level.

All pupils attaining level 6 at KS2 (including those who had no KS1 results) will be treated as having made two levels of progress.

Similarly, all pupils with W or level 1 at the end of KS2 (including those with no KS1 results) will be treated as not having made two levels of progress.

Also any pupils who have a non-numerical KS2 result after combining the test and TA using the above method are treated as not having made expected progress.

The following table shows how levels at KS1 are mapped to those at KS2 to determine whether a pupil can be included in the progress measure and,

if included in the measure, whether or not they have made at least two levels of progress. Where a pupil is shown as "N/A",

this means that they have not been included in the calculation of the measure because there is insufficient evidence to calculate the amount of progress they have made.

Pupils who could not be assessed in their progress (N/A) have not been included into the denominator of the progress calculations.
