**Literacy:** Continue 'Mouse Bird Snake Wolf; (Fiction); 'The Lady of Shallot' (Poetry); Plays and Scripts (Fiction); Comprehension (Reading) and we will be using the literacy resource 'Story Spinner'. We will also be doing SATs practice tests throughout the term.

Numeracy: Week 1: Number, place value and negative numbers; Week 2: SATs Assessment; Week 3: Mental addition, subtraction and order of operations; Week 4: Co-ordinates, statistics and measures and assessment Week 5: Mental multiplication, division and written multiplication; Week 6: Fractions, percentages and statistics; Week 7: Algebra; Week 8: Multiplication and division of fractions and written division; Week 9: Area, perimeter and volume; Week 10:Shape, ratio and percentage Week 11: Measure We will also be doing SATs practice tests throughout the term.

**R.E:** Local Church (Community), Eucharist(Relating) and Lent & Easter (Giving) and visiting the elderly at the Alms Houses, Easter and Lent.

Science: The art of being human and living things and their habitats.

ICT: Staying safe on-line and digital citizenship.

History and Geography: Continue Shang Dynasty, China including Chinese New Year.

Art & Design: Chinese art inspired by the our partner school in China.

**PE:** The children have P.E on Monday and Wednesday afternoon.

Your continued support at home is invaluable to help your child's progression this year. Please encourage your child to engage in a wide variety of texts, including fiction and non-fiction, especially checking comprehension. As you know already, this is a very important term and we will be doing lots of work in school but practising and going over work at home would be very beneficial.
