
How to make a Jam Sandwich




With a talk partner:

You will need:




2 slices of bread

Butter/spread


Jam


Knife







1. First, get two slices of bread.






2. Next, use the knife to spread some butter onto both slices.






3. After that, use a knife to spread the jam on top of the butter.






4. Then, put one slice of bread on top of the other.



5. After that, cut the sandwich in half with the knife.



6. Finally, eat it!
