These measures are:         <ul> <li>Separation of vehicles and pedestrians</li> <li>Pedestrian crossing points</li> <li>Parking and the car park security</li> <li>Access for vehicles</li> <li>Routes suitable for potential traffic use</li> <li>General route safety</li> <li>Site rules</li> <li>Vehicle manoeuvres</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	
Reports	<ul> <li>The Headteacher reports to the Governing Body on any traffic and pedestrian incidents that have taken place and what improvement measures have been introduced.</li> </ul>	
Inform	<ul> <li>Parents, pupils and contractors are regularly reminded of the safety measures that are in place.</li> <li>School Council are also consulted on traffic issues</li> </ul>	
Annual Review	All traffic management procedures are reviewed annually.
