Dear parents: I am getting daily updates from a wide range of agencies and have gone back to doing Risk Assessments. Public Health England guidance, Department for Education guidance, Hackney Education guidance and Trade Union guidance to their members. I am starting new restrictions in school around social distancing among adults and the return of mask wearing in communal areas. I will move heaven and earth to keep the Nativities on and our Christmas Concert but regretfully have to cancel all theatre trips and visits for 2021 starting from tomorrow. There will be CO2 air monitors in every corner of the hall and if necessary and if we have to and the weather allows we will do something outside.
