



Consonants and Vowels

Vowels are the letters: a, e, i, o, u and sometimes y.

a e i o u

Consonants are all the other letters, such as: b, d, t, s, etc.

a b c d e f g h i j k l m n o p q r s t u v w x y z

What Do We Do?

Look at and read the word. Listen to the vowel sound. Ask: 'Is it long or short?'

Short Vowel Sounds

lap	lapp <mark>ing</mark>	lapping
beg	begging	begging
hit	hitt <mark>ing</mark>	hitting
nod	nodding	nodding
put	putting	putting

Rule

If the vowel is a short sound with only one consonant after it, then double the consonant in the spelling.



How Many Consonants Are after the Short Vowel?

back	ba cking	backing
stick	sti cking	sticking
stand	sta nding	standing
hunt	hu nting	hunting
bank	ba nking	banking
turn	tu rning	turning
jump	ju mping	jumping
lift	li fting	lifting

Rule

If the vowel is a short sound but has more than one consonant after it, then add '-ing'.

Rule

If it ends in 'e', drop the 'e' when adding '-ing'.

Use this song to help you remember: 'Take off the e, add i-n-g.'

Rules for Adding '-ing'

Short vowel sound, with one consonant – hitting double the consonant and add '-ing' Short vowel sound, with two jumping consonants – add '-ing' Ending in 'e' – drop the joking 'e' then add '-ing'

Long vowel sound – just add '-ing'
