Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you all had a relaxing and enjoyable Easter holiday.

Please find an outline below of the curriculum your child will be following this term in Year 3.

RE: Pentecost-Serving; Reconciliation-Interrelating; Universal Church-World.

English: In the first part of this half term we will continue to concentrate our efforts on creative writing using stories by Anthony Browne. Children will study a variety of texts to stimulate their imagination, language and thinking. They will practise writing a wide range of texts: diary entries, letters and reports. Please ensure children are reading daily at home, working on their comprehension, fluency and expression.

Maths: Place Value; mental and written addition and subtraction; Multiplication and Division; Solving word problems; Data Handling; Statistics and Geometry. Children are expected to be fluent in their knowledge of multiplication facts up to 12X.

Science: Plants; Cliff and Sea habitats.

Geography: Coast of the U.K.

Art&Design: designing and creating posters and presentations to promote a coastal location.

Computing: Videoing performance using iMovie; Internet Safety.
