Testing capacity in the borough has been extended and there are now 4 testing sites:

Bentley Road - Walk through only

Bentley Road car park, Dalston, N1 4DB
8am - 8pm seven days a week

Hackney Central - Walk through only

340 Mare St, E8 1HA
8am - 8pm seven days a week

Stamford Hill - Walk & drive through

Yesodey Hatorah School, Egerton Road, N16 6UB
10.30am-3.30pm on the following days: 18 and 25 October

Hackney Marshes - Walk & drive through

Hackney Marshes Leisure Centre,
Homerton Rd, London E9 5PF
10.30am-3.30pm on the following days: 12, 15, 21, 27 and 30 October

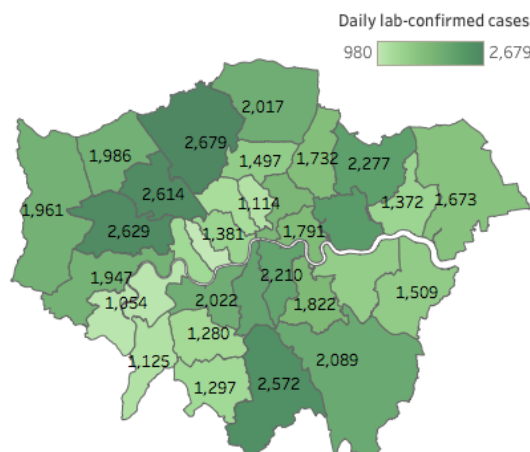

Covid-19 cases by borough

Data from Public Health England shows the highest number of Covid-19 cases recorded by 7 October 2020 were in **Barnet** - **2,679** cases in total. Generally, a higher number of Covid-19 cases are seen in the south and north-west London boroughs. In total, **1,863** Covid-19 cases have been recorded in Hackney and City.

In the last two weeks (fortnight ending 7 October 2020), the highest number of cases have been observed in **Redbridge** (**475** cases). The lowest number of cases have been observed in **Sutton** (95 cases).
