# Bentley Road - Walk through only

### Hackney Central - Walk through only

340 Mare St, E8 1HA 8am - 8pm seven days a week

#### Stamford Hill - Walk & drive through

Yesodey Hatorah School, Egerton Road, N16 6UB 10.30am-3.30pm on the following days:18 and 25 October

## Hackney Marshes - Walk & drive through

Hackney Marshes Leisure Centre, Homerton Rd, London E9 5PF

10.30am-3.30pm on the following days: 12, 15, 21, 27 and 30 October

#### Covid-19 cases by borough

Data from Public Health England shows the highest number of Covid-19 cases recorded by 7 October 2020 were in Barnet - 2,679 cases in total. Generally, a higher number of Covid-19 cases are seen in the south and north-west London boroughs. In total, 1,863 Covid-19 cases have been recorded in Hackney and City.

In the last two weeks (fortnight ending 7 October 2020), the highest number of cases have been observed in Redbridge (475 cases). The lowest number of cases have been observed in Sutton (95 cases).
