Instructions are written for someone who needs to know how to do something.




What are instructions for?

How to Write Instructions

- 1. Have a title and a list of things you need.
- Use imperative verbs (bossy verbs) for example 'put', 'spread', 'chop', 'take'. It's a 'doing word' but it sounds like you are bossing somebody around.
- 3. Use **time conjunctions** (time words) for example first, second, next, then, after that, finally.
- 4. Bullet point or number each instruction in a list
 - Put...
 - Take
 - Mix...


- 1. Put...
- 2. Take
- 3. Mix...
- 5. Short sentences are better!

Time conjunctions

They help us put things in order.

First Second Then Next After That Finally.



Bossy verbs (imperative verbs)

- A verb is a doing word.
- A bossy verb makes a sentence bossy!
 Use Miss Bossy to help you remember!
- It makes something an order or command.
- They are direct, short and sharp.

E.g.

- Line up for assembly.
- Stop at the traffic lights.
- Mix the flour and eggs together.

Task: play 'Miss Bossy' or 'Simon Says'. You will use bossy verbs without even realising!

Can you find the bossy verb?

First, list the ingredients for the recipe.

Jump on the spot.

Next, cut along the dotted line.

Stick the picture in the middle of the card.

Can you find the bossy verb?

First, **put** the ingredients in a bowl.

Then, **jump** on the spot.

Next, **<u>cut</u>** along the dotted line.

Finally, **<u>stick</u>** the picture in the middle of the card.

The answers are in red

Example: How To Plant A Sunflower Seed

What you need:

- A small pot
- Soil
- Seeds
- Watering can

<u>List of what</u> <u>you need</u>



What you do:

- First, fill the pot with soil.
- Then, add water to the soil.
- Next, put 1 or 2 seeds onto the soil.
- After that, cover the seeds with more soil.
- Finally, pour more water onto the soil.

Bossy verbs
