Dear Parents,

I hope you had a peaceful and enjoyable Christmas and New Year! I have included all the topics we will be learning in the 1st half (blue) and 2nd half (green) of the term for each subject.

Literacy: The Story Spinner - Grandad and the Laundry Basket (Fiction); The Spiderwick Chronicles: The Field Guide by Tony DiTerlizzi and Holly Black - novel (Fantasy)

Numeracy: Shape & Angles; Lines of Symmetry; Coordinates; Area and Perimeter; Number & place value; Multiplication and Division facts up to 12x; Mental & written addition and subtraction of 4-digit numbers; Two-step word problems; Multiplication & Division; Problem Solving; Fractions; Time and using a clock with direction and position; Reading scales and measurements; Data Handling; Multiplication and Division facts up to 12x.

R.E: Local Church - Community; Eucharist - Relating.

Science: States of Matter and Electricity.

ICT: We are Software Developers and We are toy designers.

History: What happened when the Romans came?

Geography: How does water go round and round? (The water cycle).

Art & Design: Developing and improving drawing and painting skills.

Design & Technology: Researching and developing products that are fit for use.

Children should be reading a range of books at home, both fiction and non-fiction. It's also a good idea to read with them and test their understanding of the text. On top of this, children should be practising their times tables as often as possible. We are doing lots of work on this at school but practising them at home would be very beneficial.
