We are very busy bees this term in Nursery:

Communication, Language and Literacy: We will begin each day with a phonics session where children are divided into groups, focusing on a particular sound and forming the letter that makes that sound correctly.

We will continue to develop children's vocabulary through various speaking and listening activities. Both fiction and nonfiction books will be shared with the children and will be linked to the relevant topics. Children will have lots of opportunities to mark make or write for a variety of purposes such as writing lists, making maps and wanted posters.

Mathematical Development:

We will continue to develop children's awareness of numerals 0-10; Once secure they will move on to 10-20. This will involve rote counting, counting objects, number recognition and formation. We will be focus ion on using mathematical language in every day situations such as larger than ,taller than, smallest etc. We will also be learning the names of shapes and identifying these in our environment.
