Dear Parents,

I hope you all had a lovely, enjoyable summer! Below is the curriculum map for the Autumn Term. I have included all the topics we will be learning in the 1st half (blue) and 2nd half (green) of the term for each subject.

Literacy: The Iron Man by Ted Hughes (Fantasy); Exploring Form (Poetry); Rose Blance by Roberto Innocenti (Historical text); Information texts (Non-Fiction).

Numeracy: Number and place value; Mental and written addition and subtraction of up to 4-digit numbers; Written methods of multiplication and division and times tables up to 12x; Problem solving. Fractions; Telling the time to the closest minute and solving time word problems; Reading scales and measurements.

R.E: Domestic Church - Family, Judaism; Baptism/ Confirmation - Belonging & Advent/Christmas - Loving

Science: Living things and their habitats and Digestive System including teeth.

ICT: Collecting and Presenting Information and Using the internet safely and appropriately.

History: The Romans

Geography: Coast of the British Isles.

Art & Design: Developing and improving drawing and painting skills.

Design & Technology: Researching and developing products that are fit for use.

Children now need to know their times tables from 2 to 12 by the end of year 4. Any extra support given to them at home will be of huge benefit to your child. I also encourage you to read a variety of texts with your child. All this extra work will have a positive effect on their progression at school.
