


Visiting the Temple



Visiting the Temple


Each year, Jesus and his family made the journey from their home in Nazareth to Jerusalem for the feast of Passover.

There was an important temple in Jerusalem where the Jewish people went to worship God.



Visiting the Temple

There were no cars or trains in those days. People made most of their journeys on foot.



Jesus Is Missing!

The year Jesus was 12 years old, his family visited the temple as usual. After they had worshipped at the temple, Jesus' family set off on the journey home.

The Temple Again

Mary and Joseph went back to Jerusalem to look for him. They looked for three days until they found Jesus in the temple.

To their amazement, they found Jesus surrounded by grown-ups. Jesus was talking to the adults about the scriptures (Jewish special book) and asking them questions.

The adults in the temple were amazed at how wise Jesus was.
