	English	We will continue to write for different purposes and audiences. Within our lessons, we will cover a range of grammar and punctuation skills. We will work on our comprehension skills by answering questions based on our class books such as; Varjack Paw, Street Child and by also completing stand-alone comprehensions.
+ - × ÷	Maths	In maths, we will complete our fractions topic and then move onto decimals. We will also be learning about money; time; shape; statistics and position & direction. We will continue to focus on fluency skills. We will be working hard on our times tables to be ready and confident for the timetable check in June.

	Science	In science, we will complete our electricity topic and begin learning about states of matter.
•	History/Geography	In geography, we will be learning about rivers and the water cycle. Our focus question is 'why does the water go round and round?' In Summer 2, we will be focusing on history, and our topic is Local History. Our focus question is 'why should we preserve our locality?'
	Art/D.T.	This half term, our focus is painting and sculpture. We will be learning about David Hockney. We will also be visiting the Hackney School of Food to learn how to prep and make pizzas.
