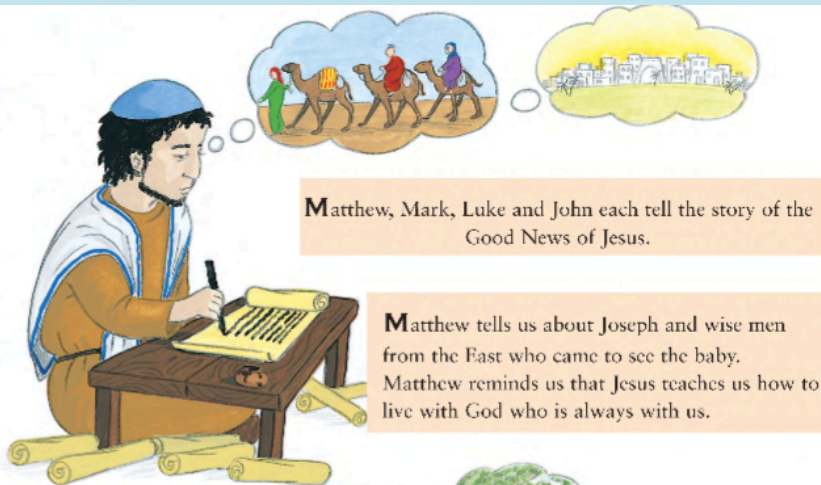


Stories from the Gospels
