Dear parents: a parent alerted me at the gate yesterday to reports of attempted abductions in the Enfield area recently. As the day progressed I received emails as well. The reports are not clear but a man and woman have been arrested about these incidents and police are appealing for calm. Pictures of a white van and two drivers are also in circulation but again unclear if dangerous or not. Vigilantes have been springing up which can often end up badly. I always mention the name of Bijan Ebrahimi a disabled Iranian entirely innocent refugee murdered by a mob in 2015. Details on Wikipedia. The email and the parent did not wish to cause any panic or alarm but always a good time to reflect on safety of our children coming to and from school. Incidents are incredibly rare but certain things can increase safety such as no earphones, no talking on mobile phones, planning routes carefully and wearing visible clothing can all help. Any parent who does want their child to go home alone must also complete a form, available from our website I will not release a child without one. Please be alert but not frightened we regularly speak to children about safety outside of school and will continue to do so. We have the police booked in for a visit later in the year as well. Last Newsletter before half-term as Thursday have to go to for an operation at UCLH Eastman hospital to have severely impacted wisdom tooth removed along with part of my jaw so won't be talking too much later in the week. What do you mean good news at last?? OK I do like to talk I admit . not much to talk about weather wise. Roll on flaming June!!

Ofsted Survey of parents 2021

Ofsted recent 2021 survey reported that 94% of parents who responded do not consider the faith-based affiliation of a school to be an important factor in choosing where to send their children. That is according to Ofsted, which has published the figures in its Parents Annual Survey 2021. Almost all parents would prefer state-funded schools that are inclusive and open to all regardless of background.

The survey of parents with school-age children was conducted by YouGov. It asked them which three of eleven key factors were most important when deciding which school was right for their child. Proximity to home was found to be the most important. For parents of pre-school children, faith affiliation was ranked last, with just 2% saying it had been important. For the parents of school-age children, it ranked tenth, with 6%. In this age group only 'the specialism of the school' ranked lower.
