



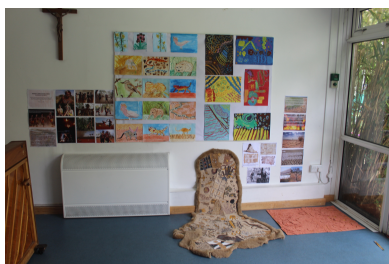

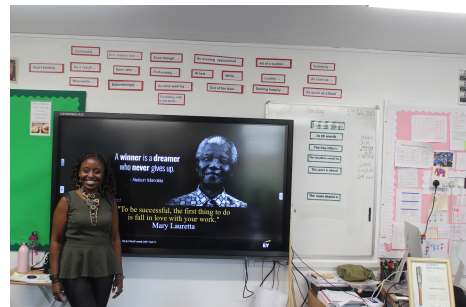
Hackney Covid-19 vaccination pop up clinics
