Aims:

1. Provide a catch-up plan to prevent DA gap from increasing during/after Covid-19 pandemic.
2. To use structured assessments throughout whole school to identify accurate pupil information.
3. To deliver a range of 1:1 and small group, high quality interventions through the whole school.
4. To assess and establish the needs in EYFS & KS1, focusing on early language, phonics, social and communication skills.
5. To raise awareness of mental health, hygiene and social parameters to create a safe school environment for all.
6. To support and give guidance to pupils who are experiencing social, emotional and behavioural difficulties due to the impact of the pandemic.
7. To provide technical support for families to ensure remote learning, where possible.
8. To encompass the broader curriculum by developing cultural knowledge and an understanding of historical and current diversity equality issues.
9. Continue to provide and create a musical enrichment curriculum and musical tuition.
